Mandatory Tagging Dates

Pay attention to species/dates. You must bring your animal to be tagged to be eligible to show at San Miguel/Mora County Fair. Species will only be tagged on their assigned dates.

Steers, Heifers: Tues. 3/5/25 4:30 pm – 7:00 And Sun. 3/9/25 8:00 am – 12:00.

Pigs, Lambs, Goats: Sat. 4/26/25 8:00 am- 12:00 And Wed. 4/30/25 4:30 pm -7:00.

Rabbits, Poultry: Thursday 7/17/25 5:00 pm -7:00. (one tagging date)

*Livestock purchased, must provide a bill of sale at tagging.

*Livestock purchased out of state must provide a copy of Interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection(s) and possibly a brand inspection.

*in-state show cattle must be branded with a New Mexico-registered brand and have written permission if the brand is not registered to current 4-H family.

*NMLB Inspection Certificates may be obtained at tagging and must be provided prior to tagging.
